# Measurement of Success

- Gather social media interaction
- Get your Google Analytics or websites data



## Semiquincentennial Grants

- “Restore and **Preserve** sites and structures **listed** in the National Register of Historic Places that commemorate the founding of the nation.”
- Eligible applicants include states, tribes, local governments, and non -profits
- Preference for state owned properties
- Sites prior to December 31, 1800 (first contested election in US)
- Broad start date, pre -contact forward
- No match required
  - FY2021 \$10 million
  - FY2022 \$10 million
  - FY2023 \$10 million
- FY2023 Applications available July 2023
