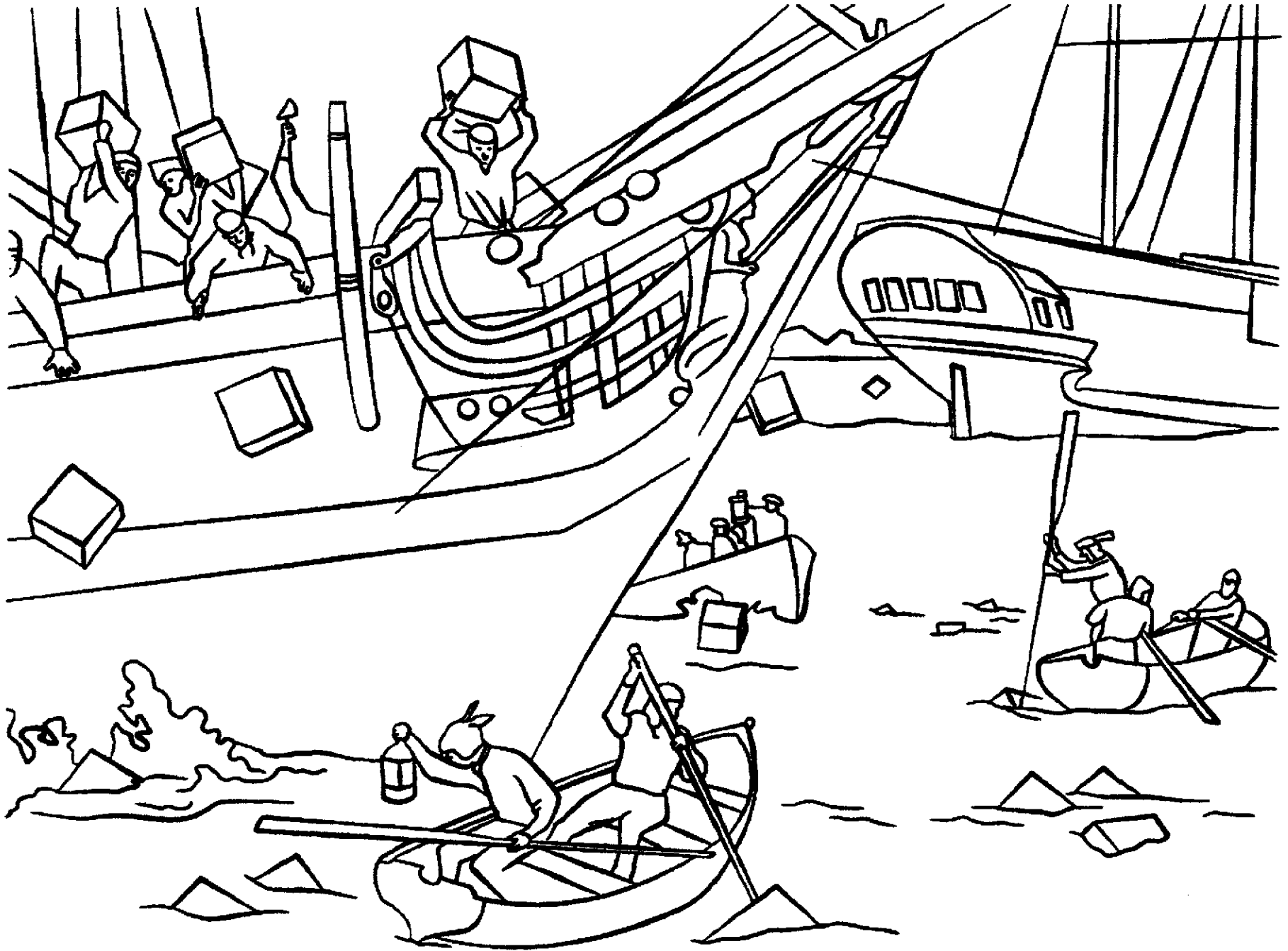

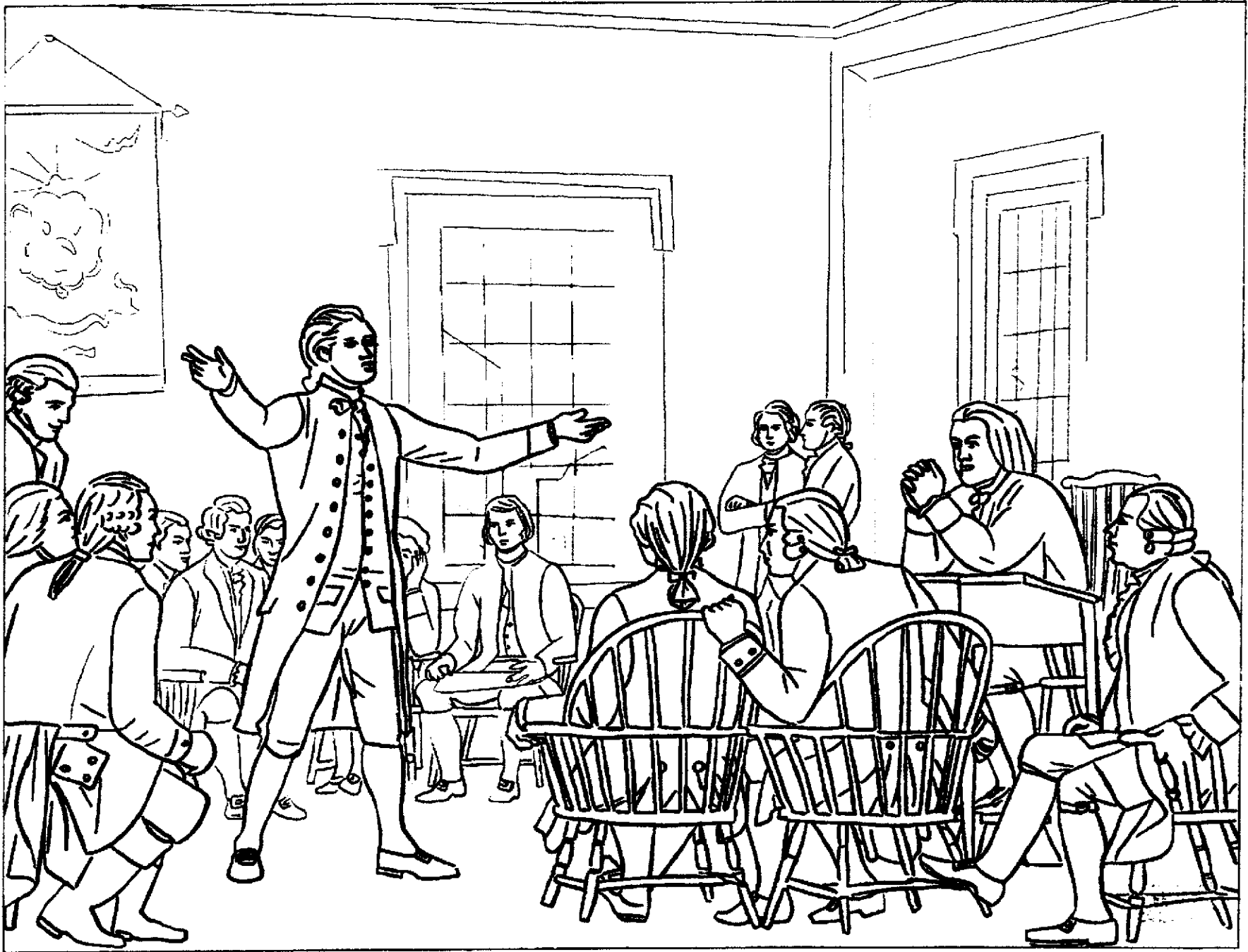

# Map of the thirteen colonies in America in 1775

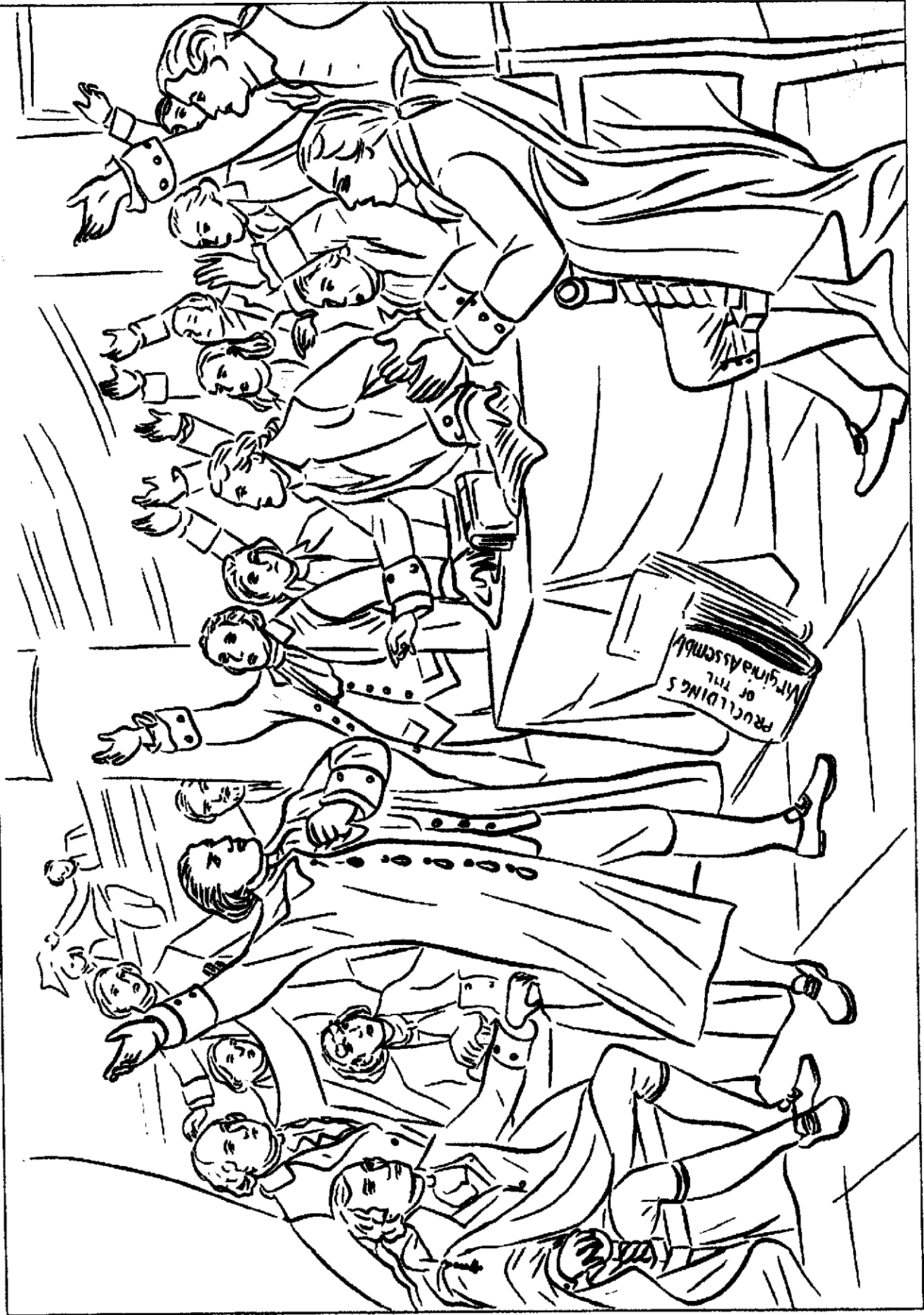


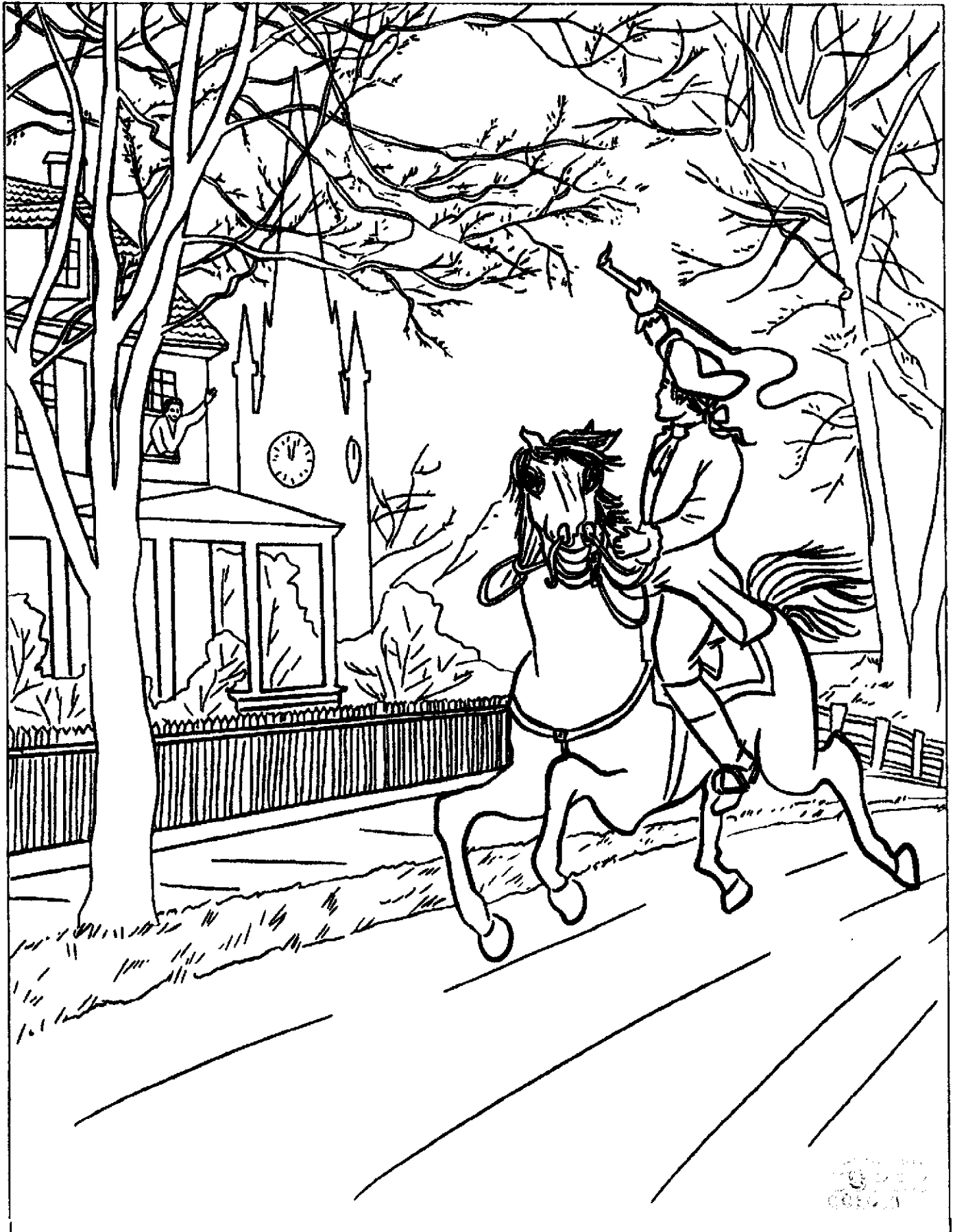
